





International dimension of Erasmus+ 2021-2027




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- Strong international dimension, linked to the EEA and the DEAP, allow:
 - cooperation between education and training institutions,
 - strengthen Europe's reputation,
 - support the green and digital transitions,
 - tackle current and future crisis.
- Closer alignment of European international cooperation actions with the EU priorities
- Foster greater coordination among the EU and MS, strengthen Europe's positioning as a key partner in education at global level and cement the links between the EEA and the rest of the world
- New regions – Pacific and Caribbean with a dedicated budget




- 2021-2027 programme: mixed funding **E+ budget line** and **External financial instruments**

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Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters (EMJM)

- Changes already present in the 2021 Call
- Institutions from **all over the world** may submit a proposal on behalf of an international consortium
- New terminology
- KA1 ➡ KA2
- New funding mechanism – incentives to sustainability
- **Erasmus Mundus Design Measures (EMDM)**: New sub-action, supporting the design of high-level study programmes at master level; € 55k lump-sum



Capacity building for higher education

- 2-3 year Partnerships of HEIs from EU MS & associated third countries and non-associated third countries.
- Lump sums
- Three types of project
 - **NEW**
 - **FOSTERING ACCESS TO COOPERATION IN HE** (24-36 months):
 - smaller scope projects focused on universities & LDCs – priority to newcomers - €200-400k
 - **PARTNERSHIPS FOR INNOVATION IN HE** (24-36 months):
 - larger-scale projects focused on innovation, university/business and governance € 400-800k
 - **STRUCTURAL REFORM PROJECTS** (36-48 months)
 - focus on policy reforms - require involvement of ministries € 800-1000k



Closer alignment of European international cooperation actions with the EU priorities

Overarching priorities

- **Smart:** digital technology in the poorest countries by building foundations for digital skills, digital transformation and data technologies
- **Green deal:** including climate change, environment and energy; enabling a profound change in institutions and peoples' behaviour and skills.
- **Growth & Jobs:** foundational skills, 'soft' skills (e.g. problem solving, communication), and Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Maths (STEAM). Education and employability
- **Inclusion and diversity:** making education systems themselves more equitable.
- **Values:** laying the foundations for strengthening active citizenship and building specific expertise of future policy-makers in areas such as democracy, human rights and multilateralism
- **External policy priorities:** governance, peace and security, migration partnerships, SDGs



Capacity building for higher education

- **Priorities:**

- **National – only for Strand 3**
- **Regional: overarching; regional targets**


Geographical targets for the following regions

- **For Eastern Partnership countries:** for Strands 1 and 2 priority will be given to HEIs from non-capital and/or rural and/or more remote regions;
- **For Asia, Central Asia, Middle East and Pacific:** For Strands 1 and 2 priority will be given to least developed countries;
- **For Sub-Sahara Africa:** For all Strands 1 and 2 Priority will be given to the least developed countries; a special emphasis shall also be put on migration priority countries and on regional projects involving HEIs from several countries; no country will access more than 8% of funding foreseen for the Region;
